PROJECT UPDATE

Mt Fyans Wind Farm is located in Victoria's Southwest Renewable Energy Zone.


When approved, the Mt Fyans Wind Farm will host up to 81 wind turbines, and generate around 400 megawatts, enough energy to power an estimated 280,000 homes – around all of the Victorian Western districts and Ballarat and Bendigo regions.



Following extensive consultation with project landholders, neighbours and the community, the number of turbines for the project has been reduced from 85 to 81. The change in design will help to reduce visual and noise impacts and further reduce environmental impacts.

The wind farm's proposed transport route has also been changed to avoid oversize vehicles travelling in close proximity to Mortlake and all traffic to the site will now use the Hamilton Highway.

Feedback from the community and local agencies has been invaluable in refining the project's design.



Planning Application submitted to DELWP

The Mt Fyans Wind Farm has reached another milestone, submitting a amended Planning Application to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) in late August.

The Planning Application was updated following extensive consultation and feedback from the community and project stakeholders.

The Planning Application will be reviewed by DELWP and agencies such as CFA and Department of Transport. When the review determines that the application is comprehensive and complete the application will be placed on exhibition available for public review. A public notice will appear in local papers advertising when Public Exhibition is open.

Mt Fyans Wind Farm donated \$50,000 to build a new helicopter emergency landing area. Also opening were a new light system, turn and sprinklers.

The new all-weather emergency helicopter landing area will streamline patient transfers by allowing emergency helicopters to land on a new hard surface at the Mortlake Recreation Reserve. Previously ambulances have needed to drive onto the grass to meet helicopters and would often get bogged.
